ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON DISRESPECT FOR OFFICIALS

Zero Tolerance Policy on Disrespect for Officials

Effective November 15, 1996, Soccer Nova Scotia adopts zero tolerance program on disrespect for officials. Disrespect for officials includes:

- Using abusive or foul language toward an official
- Continuing to disagree with the referee's decision
- Directing verbal or non-verbal insults and clear and unambiguous gestures of an insulting nature at an official
- Physically confronting an official by invading his/her personal space and not retreating when told to do so
- Initiating intentional physical contact with an official during a discussion of game activities before, during and after the game

Persons abusing the zero tolerance rules will be brought before the Soccer Nova Scotia Discipline and Appeals Committee for a hearing.
